NOTES:

In their first and second years, students should plan on completing

- English 9
- 4 two-credit modules of the ENGL 20/21: (RYEO)
- English 4: Writing in the Discipline of English (2-credits)

Within the courses selected to meet major requirements, students should include:

- 2 courses before 1800 (at least 50% of content before 1800)
- 2 seminars
- 4 upper level courses
- 1 course in [non-canonical, world, ethnic, gender]

Extra-departmental courses that count toward the major:

- 1 upper-level writing course may be counted toward the major as an upper-level course
- 2 courses from a study abroad program may be counted toward the major as upper level courses with adviser/departmental approval
- 1 course from a literature department other than English may be counted toward the major with departmental approval if the student demonstrates relevance to course of study
- 2 seminars must be taken in the department; they may not be replaced by any of the above
